To understand how working together can benefit your child, it is first important to understand the district’s and school’s goals for student academic achievement

Hall County School System GOALS:

- By the end of FY21, the percentage of students in each subgroup moving into the “Proficient” and “Distinguished” levels of performance on the Georgia Milestones Assessments will increase by 2% in the “Proficient” and “Distinguished” levels of performance.
- By the end of FY21, the “Closing the Gaps” score will increase by 10% (based on Fy20 “Closing the GAPS” score) at each level (elementary, middle, and high).
- By the end of FY21, the percentage of Economically Disadvantaged students moving into the “Proficient” and Distinguished” levels of performance on the Georgia Milestones ELA Assessment will increase by 3% in the “Proficient” and “Distinguished” levels of performance

Sardis Enrichment School GOALS:

- Sardis K-3 teachers will participate in professional learning on research-based best practices for the acquisition of systematic literacy instruction and then implement those strategies as measured by an increase in the percent of students reading on grade level on EOY DRA scores.
- Sardis Enrichment School will focus on math fact fluency, as measured by an increased percentage of students mastering grade-appropriate facts with math Facts and GKIDS 2.0.
- Sardis will provide Type 1 enrichment activities and opportunity for service learning for 100% of our students, as well as additional opportunities for Types II and III.

To help your child meet the district and school goals, the school, you, and your child will work together to:

SCHOOL/TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards by:

- Provide a link on the school website to The Learning Support Center, which provides parents with a powerful set of mobile-friendly resources to support their child as he or she acquires the reading, writing, and mathematical skills crucial for ensuring academic success.
- Send folders home each week communicating standards, sight words, and vocabulary to be mastered.
- Provide workshops to assist parents in understanding how to help their child improve reading fluency.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Visit The Learning Support Center website to access and use reading and math instructional resources with my child.
- Read with my child and help him/her study math facts.
- Check and use the folders provided by the teacher each week to support my child in mastering the standards including vocabulary.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Encourage my parents to use The Learning Support Center website to assist me with my skills in reading and math.
- Read at home with my family and study math facts.
- Work with my family on the suggestions provided in the folder including mastering the vocabulary words.
