

4th Grade

The 4th Grade Safer, Smarter Kids curriculum consists of 5 lessons that can be covered in 2, 30-45 minute sessions. Session 1 would consist of Lessons 1 & 2, and Session 2 would consist of Lessons 3, 4, & 5.

Lesson 1: Kids' Bill of Rights

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 1
- Discuss Key Vocabulary and what each term means: Childhood; Identity; Privacy; Respect; Safety and Voice

Lesson 2: Voice: The Right To Be Heard

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 2
- Reinforce your students using their voice and identifying their Safety NETWORK. Remind them that one member of their Safety NETWORK should be outside of their family.
- Briefly discuss characteristics of members of their Safety NETWORKs

Lesson 3: Respecting Boundaries

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 3
- Briefly introduce and discuss each of the warning signs of body boundary violations
 - Done with hurtful intent
 - Usually done in secret or when nobody's looking
 - Makes you feel hurt, uncomfortable, confused, or icky
 - Involves the private parts of the body
 - Makes you feel embarrassed or ashamed
 - You are told not to tell

Lesson 4: Identity: The Right To Be Who You Are

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 4
- Reinforce the concepts from the Lesson 4 Video (Expectations, Identity, Unique)

Lesson 5: The Responsibilities of Your Rights

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 5
- Discuss Rights & Responsibilities - Characteristics of each and the one big similarity
- Briefly review all information covered in the lessons
