

## 5th Grade

The 5th Grade Safer, Smarter Kids curriculum consists of 5 lessons that can be covered in 2, 45 minute sessions. Session 1 would consist of Lessons 1,2 & 3, and Session 2 would consist of Lessons 4, & 5.

### Lesson 1: Peer Pressure - Finding the Courage within You

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 1
- Discuss Key Vocabulary and what each term means: Peer Pressure; Courage
- Discuss what Lauren said in the video, "If you do the right thing, you will keep the right friends."

### Lesson 2: Cyber Bullying

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 2
- Discuss Key Vocabulary and what each term means: Cyber Bullying; Cyber P.L.A.N.; Harassment
- Briefly discuss the part of the Cyber P.L.A.N. P - Permission; L - Location; A - Activity; N - Name
- If time permits read the scenarios on page 13-14 of the teacher guide and ask the questions listed.

### Lesson 3: Privacy

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 3
- Discuss Key Vocabulary and what each term means: Privacy; Private Parts
- Briefly discuss the definition of privacy and that privacy is different from a safe secret or unsafe secret (see page 19 for additional commentary).

### Lesson 4: Body Boundaries

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 4
- Discuss and Reinforce key vocabulary from lesson 4. Violated; Body Boundaries; Grooming; Trust
- Spend additional time talking about grooming; what it is, and how to recognize the warning signs of grooming.

### Lesson 5: The Courage to Change

- Show Safer, Smarter Kids Video for Lesson 5
- Discuss Key Vocabulary: Courage; Peer Pressure; Boundaries; Voice; Safety NETWORK
- Ask the students to share one thing that they have learning during the lessons that will make them a Safer and Smarter Kid
